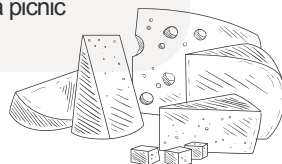
Arrondissement #10 Les Deux Gares

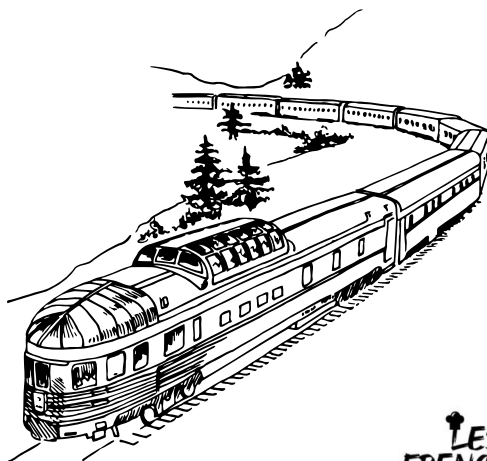

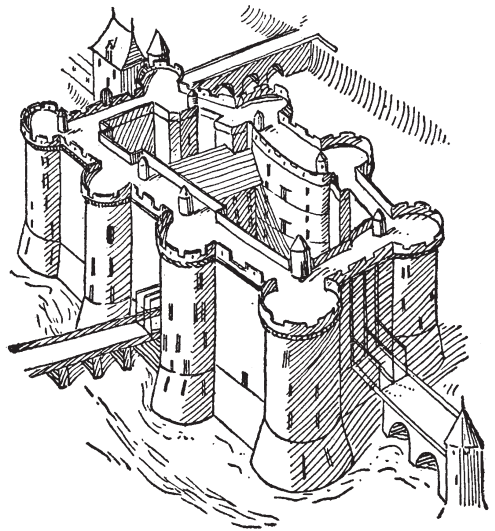

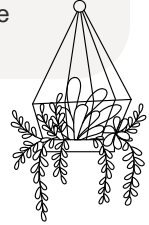

There are two main attractions in the 14th Arrondissement, The Paris Catacombs and the Montparnasse Tower with breathtaking panoramic views of Paris. Main transportation centers here are Montparnasse train station (service to Bordeaux and Brittany Region) and the Denfert Rochereau Metro & RER Station connecting to Orly airport.

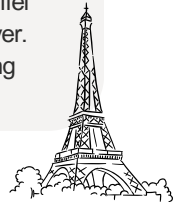

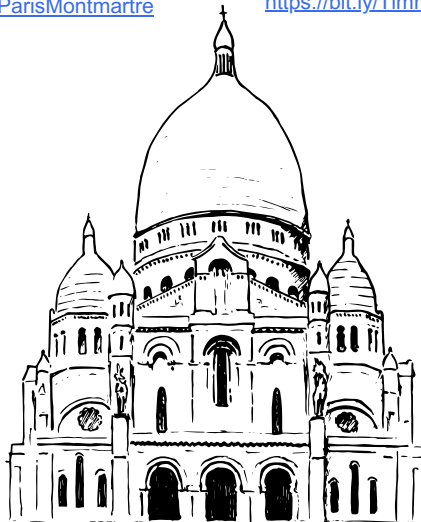
